



Monday: Jeremiah 31:1-14

1. Jeremiah's prophecy is for the "latter days" (Jer. 30:24; 31:1). Why are the Jewish people brought back to the promise land?
2. What will those who return to the promise land do once they are there?
3. What do you learn about the character of the LORD from this reading?
4. Missionary of the week: Pray for Ron and Debbie Fuqua as they share Christ and help plant churches in Romania with Wycliff Bible Translators.

Tuesday: Jeremiah 31:15-30

1. Though there would be pain and sadness at the coming exile, what is God's promise?
2. Ephraim was one of Joseph's sons, but by this time of Jeremiah's writing it was another name for Israel. How does Ephraim show repentance?
3. In what way is God shown to be a loving father?
4. Pray for the people in your Oikos or "5 for 5".

Wednesday: Jeremiah 31:31-40

1. What is the new covenant for Israel about?
2. What are the similarities between what Jeremiah and Ezekiel writes about the new covenant? (See Ezekiel 36:24-29)
3. Jesus offered this new covenant to Israel, but the great majority rejected it. (See Acts 28:23-28; Heb. 8:7-13). When will ethnic Israel fully receive what the prophets promised? (See Rom. 11:25-29)
4. Pray for people where they work and live that they would honor God in all they do.

Thursday: Jeremiah 32:1-25

1. Jeremiah finds himself in prison during the third and final attack (588-587 B.C.) Nebuchadnezzar brought against Jerusalem. Why is Jeremiah in prison?
2. Why did God have Jeremiah buy a field from his cousin in the midst of this siege?
3. Jeremiah bought the field even though he seems to not fully understand why (vs. 25). What lesson do you learn from Jeremiah's example?
4. Pray for government leaders both locally and globally.

Friday: Jeremiah 32:26-44

1. What do you learn about sin and the human condition?

2. Though Judah and Jerusalem were facing the consequences for their sin, what does the LORD promise them?
3. How does the LORD's answer to Jeremiah's prayer provide reassurance and understanding for buying his cousin's field?
4. Pray for family and friends.

Saturday and Sunday

Review what you read in Jeremiah this week. Pray for those serving Christ faithfully and pray for the services on Sunday. Pray the prayer of Ephesians 3:13-21.
