



Monday: Jeremiah 4:1-4

1. What is the three-step process if you will, in Israel's call to repent? (vs. 1-2)
2. True repentance is shown by faithfulness to the LORD. How does the LORD communicate to his people what true faithfulness looks like in order to produce the fruit he desires? (vs. 3-4; See also Deut. 10:16; 30:6)
3. What is the consequence for a disobedient, unrepentant heart? (vs. 4)
4. Missionary of the week: Pray for Turkish Connections International and Dr. Richard Freeman as they lead the planting of new churches throughout Turkey and sustaining strength for local pastors.

Tuesday: Jeremiah 4:5-31

1. In this section Jeremiah is prophesying of the coming invasion of Babylon. Who is responsible for this impending doom? (vs. 18)
2. What is the difference between wisdom and foolishness? (vs. 22; Prov. 1:7)
3. What is God's gracious promise in the midst of judgment? (vs. 27)
4. Pray for people in your Oikos or in your "5 for 5".

Wednesday: Jeremiah 5:1-13

1. What are some verses, words, or phrases that stand out to you which show the spiritual condition of God's people?
2. The LORD says he, "fed them to the full (vs. 7)." God abundantly provided for Israel but how did the people respond to the prosperity he gave them? (vs. 7-9)

3. What were God's people blinded to? (vs. 12-13)
4. Pray for people where they work and live that they would honor God in all they do.

Thursday: Jeremiah 5:14-31

1. Once God sends his judgment and the people wonder why, what is God's response? (vs. 19)
2. What reason does the LORD give for why people should fear him?
3. What is the appalling and horrible thing that has happened in the land and what does this reality reveal about the people?
4. Pray for government leaders both locally and globally.

Friday: Jeremiah 6

1. Jeremiah is commanded to prophecy to the people (vs. 9), but he responds in frustration. What is Jeremiah frustrated about? (vs. 10)
2. How do the people prove Jeremiah's lament?
3. How does the LORD feel about our worship if we're living contrary to his ways? (vs. 20) Does God approve of his people claiming to know him, while following the world's ways at the same time?
4. Pray for family and friends.

Saturday and Sunday

Review what you read in Jeremiah this week. Pray for those serving Christ faithfully and pray for the services on Sunday. Pray the prayer of Ephesians 1:15-20.
