1. What wisdom is given regarding drinking alcoholic drinks (vs. 1)?
2. What is the foolish and wise persons response to vs. 9?
3. What is the wisdom given on love and friendship (vs. 6)?
4. Missionary of the week: Pray for Ron and Debbie Fuqua as they share Christ and help plant churches in Romania.

Tuesday: Proverbs 20:16-30

1. What is the wisdom given regarding God's justice (vs. 22-23)?
2. What are the marks of a good king (vs. 26, 28)?
3. What does it take to drive away evil (vs. 30)?
4. Pray for people in your Oikos or in your "5 for 5".

Wednesday: Proverbs 21:1-15

1. The kings of the earth might think they hold absolute power, but what does vs. 1 say? (See also Dan. 2:20-21)
2. What is the outcome for those who gain by their dishonesty, and violence (vs. 6-7)?
3. How do the wicked and the righteous regard true justice?
4. Pray for people where they work and live that they would honor God in all they do.

Thursday: Proverbs 21:16-31

1. What are the wrong desires found in vs. 17, 20, 25-26, and what is their outcome?
2. What is the difference or contrast between the person of vs. 23 and the “scoffer” (vs. 24)?
3. What do these verses communicate about the power of the kingdoms of man, compared to the power of the kingdom of Christ (vs. 30-31)? (See also: Matt. 16:18; Dan. 7:13-14; Rev. 19:11-21)
4. Pray for government leaders both locally and globally.

Friday: Proverbs 22

1. What wisdom is found in the following verses regarding the rich and the poor (vs. 2, 7, 9, 16, 22-23)?
2. What wisdom is given regarding raising children (vs. 6, 15)?
3. What are we to do with God’s Word that’s been given to us (vs. 17-19)? (See also: Ps. 1:2; 119:11; 2 Cor. 10:5; 1 Pet. 3:15; 2 Tim. 4:2)
4. Pray for family and friends.

Review what you read in Proverbs this week. Pray for those serving Christ faithfully and pray for the services on Sunday. Pray the prayer of Ephesians 3:13-21.
